The Combined Federal Campaign (CFC) is the largest and most successful workplace fundraising campaign in the world. During more than fifty years of operation, the CFC has raised \$7 billion to help neighbors in need around the corner, across the nation and throughout the world.

CFC is the only authorized solicitation of Federal employees in their workplace on behalf of approved charities.

\$1 PER WEEK

Provides a nutritional meal for a frail elder at a senior day center

Affords an at-risk child one week of an after school program

Plants a tree in an inner-city neighborhood

Provides a gift box of toys to brighten the day of a child fighting cancer

IF \$1 CAN DO SO MUCH, JUST IMAGINE...

\$2 PER WEEK provides mosquito nets that can save the lives of eight African children

\$3 PER WEEK provides six months of counseling sessions for a family dealing with Alzheimer's

\$5 PER WEEK provides temporary shelter for a family of four for three nights following a disaster

\$10 PER WEEK provides breakfast for 10 children for the entire summer
